Care and Cleaning

Your new Pony Pump was designed to provide many years of satisfactory performance. To assure that with each and every keg the product being served is at its best, we recommend that you follow the care and cleaning procedures listed in this guide.

Periodically, the "plunger o-ring" will require slight lubrication.* This will permit proper movement of the plunger when pumping. DO NOT OVER LUBRICATE as this can affect pumping action.

*A FDA approved silicone lubricant is recommended and can be purchased at your local hardware store. Do not use other lubricants as they may have an adverse affect on the pump's performance.



Cleaning: After each use of your Pony Pump just follow these simple steps

1. Fill bucket or sink with clean fresh cold water. and attach blue cleaning cup over pump body bottom seal.

- 2. Place faucet "in open" position and locate as shown. Submerge pump and hold in place.
- 3. Pump sufficiently to allow steady stream to flow through hose and faucet. (This will rinse away any beer or sediment build up). Remove Pony Pump from water.



- 4. Disassemble by removing locking ring (lift from body) and rinse inside of pump body with fresh. clean water; dry all parts thoroughly. Carefully check plunger o-ring and clean o-ring groove.
- 5. Assemble component parts, making sure locking ring "snaps" in place.
