Tapping Instructions



1. Depress plunger and hold pump body as shown, align notches in base of Pony Pump with corresponding lugs located in the top of the keg valve.




2. While holding firmly in a vertical position, press pump body down onto the keg valve.



3. Rotate the pump body one-quarter turn clockwise to engage the keg lugs. (This locks the pump in place and opens keg valve).

Handling Check List

- Always follow recommended tapping procedures, don't use your Pony Pump as a handle to lift or move the keg.
- When lifting keg, do use handles provided on keg. Do not roll or drop keg as this will cause unnecessary foaming once tapped.
- Avoid over pumping, pump only enough to maintain desired flow.
- Once tapped, open faucet in one motion, quickly (any hesitation may cause foam).
- Remember, draft beer is a food product and must be kept cold (36° - 40°) at all times, or it will spoil.
